They are exposed to arts, photography, cooking, hiking, and more while getting to know one another and their strengths in the backdrop of the peaceful and mazestic town of Big Horn, Wyoming. A community of strong women develops. Camp Wyoming was not just a vacation -- it was a time for healing, sharing, safety and inspiration, more than two thousand miles away from the young adults' challenged nome environments. They leave their mental and behavioral-health 'labels' behind and open their eyes to new and unique opportunities, realizing everyone has something good to give and the potential to succeed. With individual love and attention from the entire camp staff, practical life skills and a world of possibility were presented in a positive atmosphere, to help the young women connect more intimately with their strengths and navigate more successfully down the road of life.
